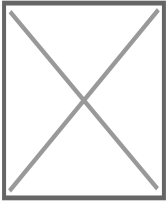


Section 4.13 Statelessness in the asylum context



Statelessness is a legal anomaly which affects those who are not considered a national by any state. Lacking any state's protection means stateless persons may not be able to fully realise their fundamental rights, including access to education, health care, housing, employment, social welfare and

documentation.
