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6.1. Relevant circumstances

COMMON ANALYSIS

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In the context of Belgravia, numerous circumstances and different profiles may require consideration of the potential applicability of exclusion grounds. The QD does not set a time limit for the application of the grounds for exclusion. Applicants may be excluded in relation to events which have occurred in the recent and more distant past.

COI indicates that excludable acts are committed by many actors both in relation to armed conflicts, as well as in the context of general criminality and human rights abuses.

The examples mentioned in this chapter are non-exhaustive and non-conclusive. Each case should be examined on its own merits.

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
