The Council of Europe launched a free Human Rights Education for Legal Professionals ([HELP](#)) online course on “Asylum and Human Rights” in Tenerife, Spain, in co-operation with the Bar Association of Tenerife (ICATF) and Spain's General Council of Lawyers.<sup>933</sup> Several civil society organisations continued to report on shortcomings in the provision of legal assistance on the Canary Islands, especially for detained migrants, due to a lack of specialised lawyers in immigration matters. <sup>934</sup>

A practical guide on legal assistance for sea arrivals was published in August 2021 by the Spanish General Council of Lawyers.<sup>935</sup> The guide provides information on best practices to ensure the quality of legal assistance, access to administrative files and working methods during health emergencies, such as the COVID-19 pandemic.

In a preliminary assessment, the Supreme Administrative Court in Portugal [allowed](#) a judicial review when the applicant complained of a lack of information on free legal aid in the asylum procedure, including having a lawyer during the interview. The judgment on the merits of the case is pending. Throughout 2021, UNHCR continued to provide legal information to asylum applicants in Portugal, through its partner the Portuguese Refugee Council. <sup>936</sup>
