

Exclusion and end of protection

The European Asylum Curriculum includes a dedicated focus on the complex topic of exclusion, which addresses situations where individuals are deemed undeserving of international protection. Through its three specialised modules, the curriculum guides practitioners in understanding and applying exclusion clauses effectively. The first module covers the Application of exclusion clauses to persons undeserving of international protection, ensuring a sound grasp of the legal and procedural aspects. The second module, End of protection, explores scenarios in which protection ceases to apply. Finally, Identification of potential exclusion cases equips participants with the necessary skills to recognise such cases early in the process. Together, these modules support consistent and fair decision-making, in line with EU standards and obligations.

On the topic of Exclusion, the European Asylum Curriculum offers 3 modules, namely:

- End of protection
- Identification of potential exclusion cases
