Another topic of increased interest in 2023 was <u>COI on the LGBTIQ</u> community. The EUAA rebranded its practical COI Research Guide on LGBTIQ for COI researchers. <u>820</u>The Asylum Research Centre published a series of query responses that presented COI on the situation and treatment of LGBTIQ persons in <u>Egypt</u>, <u>Tunisia</u> and <u>Uganda</u>. <u>821</u> In addition, Asylos published reports on the treatment of homosexual men and their relatives in <u>Kenya822</u> and on the situation of homosexual people in <u>Togo</u>. <u>823</u>
