The dire humanitarian situation in the country has a significant impact on all elements considered under the requirement of reasonableness to settle in a different part of the country, including means of basic subsistence and employment, food security, housing and shelter, water and sanitation, and basic healthcare. **Therefore, based on the general situation in Sudan, including Port Sudan, the reasonableness to settle criterion under Article 8 QD/QR would, generally, not be met.**
