

2.7.3. Sool, Sanaag and SSC-Khatumo - Checkpoints and road security

In April 2023, the Dhulbahante committee in Laas Caanood announced that traffic between the Sool, Sanaag, and Cayn regions and Somaliland would be suspended, isolating Laas Caanood from the major port of Berbera and hindering traffic between Somaliland and Somalia. 1322

<u>Map 4</u> by IPIS shows non-al-Shabaab-controlled checkpoints in Caynabo, Guumeys, Tuulo Samakaab, Faleeryale, and Buuro Wadar in Sool region. <u>1323</u> However, checkpoints in the contested regions, notably as a consequence of the conflict in Las Anod, are likely to be many more than those shown on the map. <u>1324</u> For an overview on checkpoints at country level see section 1.7 Checkpoints and road security in Somalia.
