The **EUAA website** is designed and maintained to be accessible to as many users as possible, including persons with disabilities.

You should be able to:

- **Zoom up to 400%** without issues.
- **Navigate most of the website using just a keyboard.**
- **Use a modern screen reader and speech recognition software** on both desktop and mobile devices.

The website is undergoing continuous assessment to ensure compliance with [EN 301 549 v.3.2.1](#) technical standard for websites and mobile applications. This standard aligns closely with [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\) 2.1 Level AA](#) to ensure accessibility and inclusivity for all users. WCAG 2.1 is based on four principles: perceivable, operable, understandable and robust.

Web accessibility aims to make web texts, images, forms and navigation accessible and understandable to the general public.

It also looks to uphold equal opportunity and equal access to information and services for people with disabilities, according to the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.

These particular standards enable access to a wide range of users, for instance people with visual or auditory impairments or learning difficulties.
