COMMON ANALYSIS Last update: October 2025

Some of the commonly reported types of harm to civilians' life or person in Somalia include killing, injury, forced displacement, etc. A real risk of such serious harm would qualify as a threat to a (civilian's) life or person in accordance with the provision of Article 15(c) QD/QR.
