



7.2.10. Access to airports and freedom of movement

To enter Jinnah International Airport, it may be required to present either a passport, a CNIC or a valid airline ticket.[2192](#) Access to Jinnah International airport is available through several public bus routes.[2193](#) The platform Region Alert[2194](#) lists the national Highway M-9 between Karachi and Lahore with a ‘low-moderate’ security risk level, mentioning highway robberies in segments in Sindh. Furthermore, Region Alert mentioned that ‘low risk’ corridors could become impassable within hours if motorway access points are blocked by political protests.[2195](#)
