



2.5.6. Conflict-related infrastructure damage and explosive remnants of war

Since the fall of the Assad regime, the main infrastructure damage occurred as a result of the insurgency on the coast in March 2025. At least one hospital and 30 schools were damaged as a result of the clashes.^{[738](#)} Furthermore, property was damaged and destroyed in 15 locations in Tartous, Latakia, and Hama in March 2025. The Qusoor neighbourhood of Baniyas in Tartous was one of several locations in the coastal region where entire villages and residential areas were destroyed.^{[739](#)}

No information could be found on incidents linked to explosive remnants of war during the reporting period.
