



2.10.5. Civilian casualties

In the period from 1 October 2025 to 31 May 2026, SNHR recorded four civilian fatalities in Damascus governorate.^{[1042](#)} Of these, two were recorded in November 2025,^{[1043](#)} one in January, and one in February 2026. Between October 2025 and May 2026, all recorded civilian fatalities in the governorate were attributed to actors that SNHR could not identify.^{[1044](#)} With a share of less than 1 % of the total countrywide number of fatalities (268), Damascus was one of the governorates with the fewest fatalities in the first quarter of 2026.^{[1045](#)} An analysis of the period since the fall of Bashar Al-Assad confirms that Damascus was among the governorates with the lowest number (around 0-3) of monthly civilian fatalities, interrupted by a significant peak (25) in June and higher numbers (10) in July 2025.^{[1046](#)}
