



2.12.5. Civilian casualties

In October 2025, the SNHR recorded 7 civilian fatalities in Dar'a governorate, 6 in November, 6 in December, 4 in January 2026, 5 in February, 1 in March, 2 in April and 3 in May, as of 1 June 2026.[1182](#) Between October 2025 and May 2026, all recorded civilian fatalities in the governorate were attributed to actors that SNHR could not identify.[1183](#) An analysis of the period since the fall of Bashar Al-Assad shows peaks in the civilian death toll in March and April 2025 followed by a general decline with two smaller peaks in June and September 2025.[1184](#)
