



2.14.5. Civilian casualties

The SNHR recorded no civilian fatalities in Quneitra governorate in October and November 2025, and one civilian death in December 2025, [1354](#) killed by a party SNHR was unable to identify.

[1355](#) SNHR recorded no civilian fatalities in the period from January to 31 May 2026. [1356](#)

An analysis of the period since the fall of the previous government shows two fatalities recorded by SNHR in the period from December 2024 to May 2025, [1357](#) none recorded in the period from June to September 2025, [1358](#) and one recorded in the period October 2025 to 10 May 2026.

[1359](#) Several civilians in Quneitra and Dar'a governorates were reportedly killed in May 2026 by debris from drones intercepted in the context of the ongoing Israeli-US conflict with Iran. [1360](#)
