Modules on AMMR

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Modules on AMMR focus on the application of the responsibility determination system within the Common European Asylum System. They support professionals in identifying indicators for the application of the AMMR, but also in determining which Member State is responsible for examining an application for international protection and in applying the relevant procedures in practice.

Who this training is for

These modules are intended for:

- Asylum officials with tasks related to the application of the AMMR
- Registration officers, AMMR officers, asylum and reception workers, who are in contact with asylum seekers.

What these modules cover

Through these modules, participants develop knowledge and skills related to:

- identifying indicators for the application of the AMMR
- Outlining effective communication skills to collect and provide information to applicants in the context of applying the AMMR

- **Applying the criteria to determine the member state responsible for examining an application for international protection, in accordance with the AMMR**
- **Carrying out different procedures in the context of the AMMR responsibility determination system.**

These competencies are essential for ensuring that responsibility determination is carried out in a consistent, efficient, and legally sound manner.

Available modules

The following training modules are included in this category:

- **Identification of potential AMMR cases**
- **Responsibility determination under the AMMR**

In addition, the following trainings are available:

- **Solidarity mechanism under the AMMR**
- **Family tracing under the AMMR**
- **Information provision to applicants with special needs under the AMMR**

These trainings address specific operational aspects of the AMMR, supporting targeted learning needs and practical implementation.
