## DESCRIPTION

**This module aims to prepare learners to conduct a personal asylum interview in complex cases. Based on the requirements of the Qualification Regulation and the five stages of the EUAA Asylum Interview Method, this module focuses on how to**

**plan and implement advanced strategies to interview applicants for international protection and explore the credibility of the statement in complex cases.**
